

**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 197**

February 20, 2004 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL
RESOURCES.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 4: before that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 1c.** 169.09 (2) of the statutes is renumbered 169.09 (2) (a) (intro.) and
4 amended to read:

5 169.09 (2) (a) (intro.) No person may sell or offer to sell or purchase or offer to
6 purchase the opportunity to hunt any wild animal that is or has been captive except
7 as authorized under ~~a bird hunting preserve license.~~ one of the following:

8 **SECTION 1e.** 169.09 (2) (a) 1. of the statutes is created to read:

9 169.09 (2) (a) 1. A bird hunting preserve license.

10 **SECTION 1g.** 169.09 (2) (a) 2. of the statutes is created to read:

11 169.09 (2) (a) 2. A dog training license, if the hunting does not involve the
12 release of a captive wild animal into the wild and does not include shooting, shooting
13 at, intentional killing, or attempting to kill any wild animal.
