

(2) if all of the following apply: (a) The feeding site is within 50 yards of an owner-occupied residence. 12-13 (b) The feeding site is not less than 100 yards from a roadway, as defined in s. 340.01 (54), having a posted speed limit of 45 miles per hour or more. 14 ¥5-(c) Not more than 2 gallons of material are at the feeding site. 16 (4) A person may feed deer for hunting purposes in counties not included in the 17 rules promulgated under sub. (2) during any season open for hunting deer if all of the 18 following apply: (a) Not more than 2 gallons of material are at the feeding site. 20 (b) No feeding site is closer than 100 yards of another feeding site. 21(c) The person does not place more than 2 gallons of material in any area 22 comprising 40 acres or less. 23 (END)


