*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3 **SECTION 1.** 29.335 of the statutes is amended to read:

4 **29.335 Feeding wild animals for nonhunting purposes.** The Subject to  
5 s. 29.336, the department shall promulgate rules to regulate the recreational and  
6 supplemental feeding of wild animals for purposes other than hunting. ~~The rules~~  
7 ~~promulgated under this section do not apply after June 30, 2004.~~

9 **29.336 Feeding deer.** (1) In this section, "feeding deer" means to place any
