Drafting Request

Amendment to AB 859 as modified by Joint Finance

Background

AB 859 provides funds to Commerce to make manufacturing extension center grants under Ch. 560.25. The amendment passed in Joint Finance uses GPR from the Wisconsin Development Fund to finance these grants.

Legislative Goal

The object of this proposed amendment is to:

1. Delete the earmark from the Wisconsin Development Fund
2. Provide \$1,500,000 GPR from the General Fund to Commerce to make grants to manufacturing extension centers
3. Maintain Revenue neutrality by requiring Commerce to lapse \$1,500,000 to the General Fund by the end of the biennium including SEG funds from the Industrial Building Loan Fund
4. The result should be a net increase of \$1,500,000 of spending on manufacturing and other businesses while having no fiscal impact

Details

- The earmark from the Wisconsin Development Fund that needs to be deleted is in the amendment to AB 859, lines 11-15
- Provide \$1,500,000 GPR from the General Fund to Commerce to make grants to manufacturing centers (under section 20.143 (1) (fj)).
- Please restore the deletion in lines 2-4 of the amendment that read: "~~No moneys may be encumbered under this paragraph for grants under s. 560.25 after June 30, 2003~~" but change the date to June 30, 2005.
- Create a new paragraph that directs the Department to lapse an amount to the general fund equivalent to the dollar amount (\$1,500,000) by which the Manufacturing Extension Center Grants (20.143 (1) (fj) was increased in FY 04. The department shall lapse this amount from appropriations under s. 20.143 by June 30, 2005, under a plan approved by the Secretary of the Department of Administration. The intent is to have the Department lapse back the amount of the new GPR provided under this bill with the flexibility to take it from other Department appropriations under a plan approved by the DOA Secretary.
- In meeting the lapse under the new paragraph (above), authorize the Department to use all or part of the unencumbered balance in s. 20.143 (1) (x) of the statutes. The intent is to permit the Department to lapse unencumbered funds under from the Industrial Building Loan Fund.

8 **4.** Page 2, line 10: delete "\$900,000" and substitute "\$750,000".

9 **5.** Page 2, line 11: delete "\$1,400,000" and substitute "750,000".

10 **6.** Page 2, line 12: after that line insert:

11 "(b) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the
12 appropriation to the department of commerce under section 20.143 (1) (c) of the
13 statutes, as affected by the acts of 2003, the dollar amount is decreased by \$1,500,000
14 for fiscal year 2003-04 to decrease funding for the purpose for which the
15 appropriation is made."

- 5 2. Page 2, line 11: delete lines 11 to 15 and substitute:
- 6 "(b) Notwithstanding section 20.001 (3) (c) of the statutes, no later than June
- 7 30, 2005, the department of commerce shall, pursuant to a plan approved by the
- 8 secretary of administration, lapse to the general fund any or all of the unencumbered
- 9 balance in any or all of the appropriations under section 20.143 of the statutes, except
- 10 that the total amount of the moneys lapsed under this paragraph may not exceed
- 11 \$1,500,000 and no lapse shall be made from any appropriation account or segregated
- 12 fund if the lapse would violate a condition imposed by the federal government on the

1 expenditure of moneys or if the lapse would violate state law or the federal or state
2 constitution.”.
