. Concerning proposed s. 6.15 (5), which relates to registration of new residents, I did not think it was appropriate for new electors to affirm that they have resided in the ward or election district for *less than* 10 days on one form and then, at the same time, affirm that they have resided in the ward or election district for *at least* 10 days on another form. Therefore, the draft provides for the municipal clerk or inspectors to offer to provide the elector with a mail registration form. If there are no such forms at the polling place, the officials can make a notation and have the municipal clerk send out the form later.
