The Division of State Facilities has been directed by members of the State Building Commission to draft a bill to amend the 2003-05 State Building Program as enumerated in 2003 WI Act 33.

Four additional projects should be included in the draft.

- 1. University of Wisconsin System Madison; School of Business Graduate School Facility -- \$40,000,000 (\$20,000,000 existing GFSB, \$20,000,000 Gifts).
- 2. University of Wisconsin System Madison; Ogg Hall Replacement and Demolition -- \$34,900,000 PRSB.
- 3. University of Wisconsin System Oshkosh; Taylor Hall Renovation -- \$13,000,000 existing PRSB.
- 4. University of Wisconsin System River Falls; Hunt Arena / Knowles Physical Education and Recreation Center Addition and Renovation -- \$2,206,000 (\$1,876,000 existing GFSB, \$330,000 existing PRSB).

In addition language will be needed to exempt Ogg Hall from the requirements of s. 101.14 (4) (b) 3, which requires all dormitories over 60 feet in height operated by UW System to be contain an automatic fire suppression system by January 1, 2006. 
