2003 WISCONSIN ACT 274

AN ACT to repeal 29.237 (1m) (a) and 29.237 (1m) (b); and to renumber and amend 29.237 (1m) (intro.) of the statutes; relating to: age requirement for sturgeon spearing license.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 29.237 (1m) (intro.) of the statutes is renumbered 29.237 (1m) and amended to read:

29.237 (1m) Subject to s. 29.024 and any limit imposed under s. 29.192 (3), a sturgeon spearing license

shall be issued by the department to any person applying for this license who: is at least 14 years old.

SECTION 2. 29.237 (1m) (a) of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 3. 29.237 (1m) (b) of the statutes is repealed.
