2003 WISCONSIN ACT 286

AN ACT *to amend* 236.43 (3) of the statutes; **relating to:** allowing counties to request that certain platted land be vacated.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 236.43 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

236.43 (3) The court may vacate land, in a city, <u>county</u>, village or town, platted as a public park or playground upon the application of the local legislative body of such city, <u>county</u>, village or town where the land has never been developed or used by said city, <u>county</u>, village or town as a public park or playground.
