2003 WISCONSIN ACT 305

AN ACT to create 118.02 (5m) of the statutes; relating to: special observance days in school.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

118.02 (**5m**) March 17, for "The Great Hunger" in Ireland from 1845 to 1850.

SECTION 1. 118.02 (5m) of the statutes is created to read:
