Amendment 1.

- 1. pg 4, delete line 1
- 2. pg 4, line 3: replace "one" with "two" and replace "assembly" with "senate"
- 3. pg 4, line 4: replace "one" with "two" and replace "senate" with "assembly."
- 4. on page 5 of LRB4400/1 delete line 1.
- 5. pg 4, line 9: replace "4" with "7"
- 6. pg 5, line 11, add, after "4," "plus a representative of Industry" (or whatever wording is appropriate.)

Amendment 2 (drafted to both LRBa2580/1 and LRB4400/1)

Add new funding mechanism under 281.34(10) that requires municipal water utilities to charge \$5.00 to connect residential water to households where the domestic water is separately metered for each household. and \$50 annual fee for commercial consumers. The connection fee is paid when the residential service is transferred to a new owner.

In addition, local jurisdictions served by a municipal water system may create an additional local fee to piggyback on the state fee to be used for water conservation and groundwater management.

Amendment 3, drafted to both a2580 and 4400:

Redefine "spring" to read: an area of concentrated perennial groundwater discharge occurring at the surface of the land that results in a flow of at least one cubic foot per second at any time during the year.

Amendment 4, drafted to 4400:

The department may allow counties to create an additional four Groundwater Protection Areas [total statewide]. The department may establish criteria for minimum size of locally created GPAs.

Amendment 5, drafted to 4400

Provide additional funding of \$300,000 or one half of the revenue generated under 281.34(10), whichever is less, annually to the Groundwater Coordinating Council for groundwater monitoring.

Amendment 6 drafted to 4400:

Direct the PSC to research and propose water fee structures that encourage water conservation and statutory changes needed to implement the proposals.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT, TO 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 926

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 12, line 13: after that line insert:

"(11) Water utility connection fee. (a) A public utility furnishing water to or for the public shall charge a connection fee whenever it connects to its water system a residence that is separately metered or a commercial building and whenever the ownership of a connected residence that is separately metered or a connected commercial building changes. The fee under this subsection is \$5 for a residence and \$50 for a commercial building. The public water utility shall pay fees collected under this subsection to the department.".
