Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This revisor's correction bill is explained in the NOTES provided by the revisor of statutes in the body of the bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 961.41 (2) (bm) of the statutes is amended to read:
5 961.41 (2) (bm) Counterfeit of phencyclidine and certain other drugs. A If a
6 person violates this subsection with respect to a counterfeit substance that is a
7 counterfeit of phencyclidine, methamphetamine, lysergic acid diethylamide,
8 gamma-hydroxybutyric acid, gamma-butyrolactone,
3,4-methylenedioxymethamphetamine

1 4-bromo-2,5-dimethoxy-beta-phenylethyl-amine, 4-methylthioamphetamine, or
2 ketamine, the person is ~~punishable by~~ subject to the applicable fine and
3 imprisonment for manufacture, distribution, delivery, or possession with intent to
4 manufacture, distribute, or deliver, of the genuine controlled substance under sub.
5 (1) or (1m).

NOTE: Adds title and conforms structure of provision to the remainder of s. 961.41
(2), as amended by 2001 Wis. Act 109. 2001 Wis. Act 16 created this provision, which was
not taken into account by Act 109.

6 SECTION 2. 961.41 (2) (cm) of the statutes, as affected by 2001 Wisconsin Act
7 109, is amended to read:

8 961.41 (2) (cm) *Counterfeit flunitrazepam. A* If a person violates this subsection
9 with respect to a counterfeit substance which that is flunitrazepam, the person is
10 ~~punishable by~~ subject to the applicable fine and imprisonment for manufacture,
11 distribution, delivery, or possession with intent to manufacture, distribute, or
12 deliver, of the genuine controlled substance under sub. (1) or (1m).

NOTE: Conforms structure of provision to the remainder of s. 961.41 (2), as amended
by 2001 Wis. Act 109. 2001 Wis. Act 109 created a title, but did not otherwise treat this
provision.
