Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Current law allows a person who is injured through the negligence of another to recover damages if the negligence of the other person exceeds his or her own negligence.

This bill prevents a person from recovering damages for any injury or death that he or she incurs if injury or death resulted from his or her felonious act and he or she is convicted of a felony for that act.

This bill will have no impact on the Department of Corrections.
