**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This legislation has very little impact on state expenditures. The State Elections Board will incorporate the change in its information and training materials.

This legislation will require several hundred town, villages and 4th class cities to increase the hours that polling places are open by as much 2 hours depending on the current opening time. Assuming that 5 election inspectors will be make minimum wage (\$5.15 hour) for those two hours, increased costs for affected municipalities will be \$51.50 per election.

**Long-Range Fiscal Implications**

Affected municipalities will have to increase the amount budgeted for staffing polling places for future elections.
