Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

There would be an added cost to the local units of government, however, that amount is indeterminate at this time. Currently, appropriation 20.465(3)(dd) is a sum certain appropriation, with a base spending authority of \$1,400,000. This funding is allocated to eight regional response teams. There would only be an added cost to the state if the Legislature decided to allocate more funding to this appropriation. If this was not an option then the current amount would have to be split among more nine instead of eight response teams.
