Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill provides that if a person commits a sixth or greater OWI offense, a court may order, in addition to the penalties provided by law, any licensing agency, or request the Supreme Court, to restrict, limit, suspend, withhold, deny, refuse to grant or issue, or refuse to renew or revalidate for a period of not more than 5 years any professional license that the person holds or applies for.

It is not known how many offenders would be affected by this bill but no impact is expected upon circuit court operations. The number of requests going to the Supreme Court regarding attorneys' licenses is also unknown but is not expected to be significant and the additional workload would be absorbed by existing personnel.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
