Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill prohibits human cloning and provides penalities including incarceration and forfeitures for violations of the law.

The Department is unable to determine how many corporations, partnerships, associations, governments and their agencies, or individuals will be convicted of this crime. It should be noted that the FY02 average annual cost to place an inmate in a DOC institution is approximately \$26,000. It should also be noted that any increase in forfeitures relating to this crime would increase the State's (Department of Justice) penalty revenues.
