Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Assembly Bill 25 would prohibit the Department of Natural Resources from promulgating a rule establishing a four-day antlerless deer hunt with a firearm (commonly refered to as a Zone T hunt) unless the rule requires that the hunt would begin on the Thursday that immediately precedes the last Friday in October. This legislation is not anticipated to have a fiscal impact, as this bill simply dictates when the special October Zone T antlerless hunt could occur and does not require additional expeditures nor does it create additional revenue for the Department.
