## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Bill Summary: Under current law, in order to qualify as a group deer hunting party, the party must consist of two or more persons hunting in a group, each of whom is using a firearm and each of whom holds a deer hunting license. This bill eliminates the requirement that all of the members of the group must be hunting with firearms.

Fiscal Impact: It is expected that this change will result in an increase in deer tagging and group hunting violations, and complaints about both. While it's currently impossible to judge the impact in terms of numbers, at this time the bureau of Law Enforcement expects to be able to absorb the additional costs within its current appropriation.
