Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill authorizes 2nd, 3rd, and 4th class cities, towns and all villages to provide police and fire protection either by creating a combined protective services department or by requiring persons in a police department or fire department to perform police protection and fire protection duties.

A combined protective services department or dual fire and police protection positions could result in salary and fringe benefits savings for local units of government. However, the Department of Employment Relations does not have information with which to determine how many governmental units would act under this bill or how much savings might be generated.
