Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

LRB-1270/1 requires the creation of two Preferred Drug Lists, PDL I and PDL II. PDL II would be available for voluntary use by private employer group health plans and individual health insurance plans. Such an incorporation of prescription drug benefits into private employer group health insurance or individual health insurance plans would likely necessitate a change in an insurer's policy form, thus requiring approval of the policy form change by OCI. Such changes may or may not create an increase in policy form filings to OCI. It is determined, however, that should an increase in policy form filings occur, OCI would be able to absorb the cost of reviewing the additional filings within the Agency's existing budget.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
