## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This legislation repeals current disclosure requirements for election campaign related communications and institutes a new series of disclosure requirements. The State Elections Board will need to revise its information and training materials to reflect the changes. The agency will also have to conduct an information and training program for candidates, campaign finance registrants (political parties, PACs etc) and local election officials.

The revision of information and training materials will cost approximately \$10,000 for development, printing and distribution. The information and training program will cost approximately \$20,000 to reach the intended audience.
