Subject Prostitution and patronizing a prostitute		

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates higher penalties for a person who is a repeat violator of the current statutes that prohibit prostitution and remaining in a place of prostitution with the intent to patronize a prostitute. Violations of these statutes are misdemeanors. Under this bill, if a person violates either of these prohibitions after having been convicted under that prohibition twice within the preceding five years, he or she is guilty of a Class E felony.

It is not known how many offenses will be charged or how many more contested court proceedings will be required because of the increased penalty under this bill. Felony proceedings generally require additional court appearances and more court hearings than misdemeanors. Additional court proceedings require judge, court reporter, court staff and juror time. These costs are borne by the state and the county. An accurate estimate of the increased costs is impossible with existing data.
