Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Bill Summary:

Assembly Bill 637 provides an exception from boathouse construction and repair limits for commercial boathouses under certain conditions.

Fiscal Estimate: The bill provides an exception, and thus eliminates revenue from boathouse repair applications that are currently processed. Very few projects are anticipated to qualify for the exception, and so any loss of revenue due to reduction in boathouse repair certifications is expected to be minimal. New boathouse construction which is currently prohibited would now be allowed, with no fiscal impact.

The Department will need to revise an administrative rule to explain the process for an individual to demonstrate eligibility for the exception. The rule revision will require an estimated 200 staff hours at an estimated cost of \$6,000. This assumes the Department would hold one public hearing, and that the rule making would not require stakeholder or technical advisory committees. Most of the work would probably be done by policy staff earning \$25-30/hour.
