Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The original wording of the rule required applicants to notify residents of properties within the proposed spray blocks directly by mail, and to also make a press release, publish a legal notice and hold a public meeting. Information presented in all of these means of notification included the location of the proposed block, insecticide to be used, timing of the treatment and how a resident could object to treatment and have their property removed from the proposed spray block. The amendment only requires the last three methods of notification, making the direct mailing optional.

This amendment will allow savings in direct notification costs for counties or municipalities that choose to take advantage of the option not to make direct mailings. Cost savings from not sending direct notification may be offset in part by increased costs for optional additional methods of indirect notification such as radio and telivisions spots or paid news releases. It is thus impossible to accurately estimate overall savings in notification costs.

The Department will encourage counties and communities to make all efforts they feel are necessary to notify residents of spray blocks. Some counties and municipalities may decide to continue to send direct mailings. Costs for optional notification methods such as direct mailings or additional media releases will be cost shared.
