Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill increases two appropriations for refunding debt. One by \$350 million and another by \$335 million for a total of \$685 million. Acutal cost of the debt would depend on the terms of financing. The \$335 authorization is only used if the true interests costs to the state can be reduced.
