#### **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

If enacted this bill requires DOA to prepare an energy impact report within 30 days of introduction on legislative proposals that impact energy policies. It also authorizes DOA to do the same an any proposed state agency rule that significantly impacts energy policies if requested by the submitting agency or the assigned standing committee of the legislature.

#### State Fiscal Impact:

In the 2002 legislative session, approximately eight bills were introduced that may have fallen under the proposed bill. Based on this experience, the Division of Energy predicts that the preparation of an energy impact report could be absorbed within its staff current workload. While the possibility exists that the proposed bill could increase the Division's workload depending on the number of legislative proposals and state agency rules that impact energy policies, the occurance of such legislative or state agency rule proposals is difficult to predict, and therefore, the state fiscal impact is unknown.
