Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

LRB 03-2824/1 directs the Department of Regulation and Licensing (DRL) to license and regulate student athlete agents. It is estimated that there are about 1300 athlete agents in practice in the United States. For the purposes of this estimate, we will assume that approximately 100 agents will apply for license in Wisconsin.

To implement and administer the provisions of this bill, the agency would require additional resources to support IT system modifications and support, rulemaking efforts, and an increased workload in the areas of credentialing and enforcement. The fiscal impact is detailed below:

TOTAL ONE TIME COSTS, Administrative Rulemaking \$12,080 (80 hours paralegal @\$27 per hour = \$2160 160 hours legal counsel @\$53 per hour = \$8480 40 hours program manager @ \$36 per hour = \$1440)

Information Technology Costs – Modifications to Processing Systems & Website \$2400 (80 hours @\$30 per hour = \$2400)

Position Needed to Administer New Program Responsibilities .50 FTE, \$31,900

.50 FTE represents hours required annually to process 100 license requests, issue 100 licenses, renew 50 licenses, screen, investigate, and resolve an estimated twelve complaints annually, and provide legal counsel response to practice questions posed by student athletes and agent applicants and licensees.

100 agents would pay \$53 every other year for licenses. Annualized revenues would be \$2,650 per year. \$265 would go to GPR-Earned and \$2,385 would be revenue to pay for the costs of the regulation.

*Salary calculations include 38.92% fringe.

Local Costs:

If an athlete agent is charged with a felony under this law, county prosecuters may have to prosecute the charge. The Department of Regulation and Licensing has no data estimating how many felony charges might result from this regulation.
