Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, specified individuals who are significantly exposed to the HIV/AIDS virus are authorized to subject the blood of the individual to whom they were exposed to a test for the virus and to receive disclosure of the test results. Among the individuals specified are emergency medical technicians, first responders, correctional officers, employees of health care providers, and staff members of state crime laboratories.

Under this bill, employees of a school district, cooperative educational service agency, charter school, private school, the Wisconsin Educational Services Program for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing, the Wisconsin Center for the Blind and Visually Impaired, and social workers who are exposed to individuals with HIV, are also allowed to subject the blood of the individual to whom they are exposed to a test for the presence of HIV.

There are not expected to be a significant number of requests for additional HIV/AIDS tests under this bill. The cost of the HIV antibody screening test at the State Laboratory of Hygiene (SLOH) is \$20. Costs of the test at a private laboratory or hospital could be up to \$50. DHFS is not responsible for these costs.

DHFS staff time may be required for consultation and technical assistance to the agencies or providers involved. It is not possible to estimate the amount of staff time involved in this activity. The fiscal effect of this bill is not expected to be significant.
