### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The fiscal estimate assumes that the existing Circus World staff will be successful in raising or securing contributions, gifts, grants and bequests of \$500,000 annually, which will be matched on a 2:1 basis to generate the maximum amount of \$1,500,000 prescribed by this bill.

#### **Long-Range Fiscal Implications**

This proposal creates the opportunity for Circus World to multiply its fund raising efforts with a 2:1 GPR match. It is difficult to determine whether this proposal will significantly enhance the current fund raising efforts by Circus World.
