## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill creates certain provisions relating to indoor environmental quality in schools, which the bill defines to include any public elementary or secondary school in the state.

This bill has no fiscal effect on the department of public instruction.

Local school districts may experience increased costs as a result of several provisions in the bill. These costs are related to making information available to students, parents and guardians, and school staff; inclusion of various provisions in construction contracts; assurances that contracts for construction address various concerns; and the implementation of proper commissioning procedures. These costs are indeterminate.
