2003 Wisconsin Act 68 directs the Department of Transportation (DOT) to designate and mark the bridge on STH 13 across the south fork of the Flambeau River in the Town of Fifield in Price County as “Freedoms Bridge” in honor and recognition of all veterans who fought to preserve freedoms in the Korean War.

Under the act, **upon receipt of sufficient contributions from interested parties**, including any county, city, village, or town, to cover the costs of erecting and maintaining markers at the bridge specified in the bill to clearly identify to motorists the designation of the bridge as “Freedoms Bridge,” the DOT is required to erect and maintain the markers. The act specifies that no state funds, other than from the receipt of contributions under this provision, may be expended for the erection or maintenance of the markers.

Effective Date: The act takes effect on November 20, 2003.
