2003 Wisconsin Act 5 ratifies the collective bargaining agreement negotiated between the State of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Employees Union, for the 2001-03 Biennium, covering employees in the technical collective bargaining unit. The technical unit consists of approximately 3,419 full-time equivalent positions and includes pilots, barbers, chemists, dental hygienists, diagnostic radiologic technicians, electronics technicians, engineering technicians, fingerprint technicians, grain inspectors, histology technicians, network technicians, lab technicians, morticians, physical and occupational therapy assistants, pharmacy technicians, property assessment technicians, and others.

Effective Date: The general effective date of 2003 Wisconsin Act 5 is May 17, 2003. However, the collective bargaining agreement ratified by Act 5 may contain other specific effective dates covering employees in the technical collective bargaining unit.
