2003 Wisconsin Act 18 ratifies the collective bargaining agreement negotiated between the State of Wisconsin and the Association of State Prosecutors for the 2001-03 Biennium, covering employees in the assistant district attorneys collective bargaining unit. The unit consists of approximately 333 full-time equivalent positions and includes assistant district attorneys.

**Effective Date:** The general effective date of 2003 Wisconsin Act 18 is May 17, 2003. However, the collective bargaining agreement ratified by Act 18 may contain other specific effective dates covering employees in the assistant district attorney collective bargaining unit.
