2003 Wisconsin Act 14 ratifies the collective bargaining agreement negotiated between the State of Wisconsin and the Teaching Assistants Association, for the 2001-03 Biennium, covering employees in the program, project, and teaching assistants of the University of Wisconsin-Madison and University of Wisconsin-Extension collective bargaining unit. The collective bargaining unit consists of approximately 1,198 full-time equivalent positions and includes program, project, and teaching assistants.

**Effective Date:** The general effective date of 2003 Wisconsin Act 14 is May 17, 2003. However, the collective bargaining agreement ratified by Act 14 may contain other specific effective dates covering employees in the program, project, and teaching assistants of the University of Wisconsin-Madison and University of Wisconsin-Extension collective bargaining unit.
