2003 Wisconsin Act 113 ratifies the collective bargaining agreement negotiated between the State of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin Professional Employees Council, for the 2003-05 Biennium, covering employees in the professional fiscal and staff services collective bargaining unit. The professional fiscal and staff services unit consists of approximately 4,769 employees (about 4,633 full-time equivalent positions) and includes accountants, auditors, child support specialists, elections specialists, grants specialists, health care rate examiners, information systems personnel, paralegals, public defender investigators, revenue agents and auditors, workers compensation examiners, and others.

Effective Date: The general effective date of 2003 Wisconsin Act 113 is January 24, 2004. However, the collective bargaining agreement ratified by Act 113 may have other specific effective dates covering employees in the professional fiscal and staff services collective bargaining unit.
