2003 Wisconsin Act 116 ratifies the collective bargaining agreement negotiated between the State of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Building Trades Negotiating Committee, for the 2003-05 Biennium, covering employees in the building trades crafts collective bargaining unit. The building trades unit consists of approximately 465 employees (about 463 full-time equivalent positions) and includes asbestos workers, bricklayers, carpenters, electricians, glaziers, painters, plasterers, sheet metal workers, steamfitters, welders, and others.

Effective Date: The general effective date of 2003 Wisconsin Act 116 is January 24, 2004. However, the collective bargaining agreement ratified by Act 116 may contain other specific effective dates covering employees in the building trades crafts collective bargaining unit.
