Assembly Bill 388 directs the Department of Transportation to designate and mark the bridge on STH 13 across the south fork of the Flambeau River in the Town of Fifield in Price County as “Freedoms Bridge” in honor and recognition of all veterans who fought to preserve freedoms in the Korean War.

Assembly Amendment 1 provides that no state funds, other than from the receipt of contributions, may be expended for the erection or maintenance of markers. Upon receipt of sufficient contributions from interested parties, including any county, city, village, or town, to cover the costs of erecting and maintaining markers, the department shall erect and maintain the markers.

LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

On June 19, 2003, the Assembly Committee on Transportation introduced and recommended for adoption Assembly Amendment 1 by unanimous consent.

The Assembly Committee on Transportation recommended passage of the bill, as amended, by a vote of Ayes, 16; Noes, 0.
