1 **AN ACT** *to create* 175.22 of the statutes; **relating to:** written policies on the use
2 of recording devices in locker rooms.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires any person who owns or operates a locker room in this state
to adopt a written policy on the use of recording devices in the locker room.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do
enact as follows:*

3 **SECTION 1.** 175.22 of the statutes is created to read:

4 **175.22 Policy on the use of recording devices in locker rooms.** (1) In
5 this section:

6 (a) "Person" includes the state.

7 (b) "Recording device" means a camera, an audio or video recorder, or any other
8 device that may be used to record or transfer sounds or images.

9 **(2)** Any person that own or operates a locker room in this state shall adopt a
10 written policy on the use of recording devices in the locker room.
