



2003 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 29

March 31, 2003 – Introduced by Representatives BIES, ALBERS, HAHN, JESKEWITZ, KRAWCZYK, LADWIG, M. LEHMAN, MCCORMICK, MILLER, OWENS, PETROWSKI and STONE, cosponsored by Senators A. LASEE and COWLES. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **Relating to:** the life of Pianist John Browning of Sister Bay, Wisconsin.

2 Whereas, world-known Grammy Award-winning Pianist John Browning died
3 on January 26, 2003, at his home in Sister Bay, Wisconsin, at the age of 69; and

4 Whereas, his long and fruitful career had deep and frequent ties to the
5 Peninsula Music Festival of Door County, where he performed from 1959 to 2000; and

6 Whereas, he also served on the board of directors of the Peninsula Music
7 Festival, bringing recognition to the festival and inspiring others to perform in
8 beautiful Door County; now, therefore, be it

9 **Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That:** the members of the
10 Wisconsin legislature commend John Browning's great musicianship and his many
11 contributions to the Peninsula Music Festival and Door County, and mourn his
12 passing; and, be it further

13 **Resolved, That** the assembly chief clerk shall provide copies of this joint
14 resolution to Betty Witchey of Santa Rosa, California, to Marian Marcellus of Sister

1 Bay, Wisconsin, and to the Peninsula Music Festival, and ask that it be read at the
2 festival's memorial concert planned for August.
