



2003 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 79

May 18, 2004 - Introduced by COMMITTEE ON ASSEMBLY ORGANIZATION, by request of Representative Gard and Senator Hansen. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **Relating to:** the life and military service of U.S. Army Specialist Nichole M. Frye.

2 Whereas, U.S. Army Specialist Nichole M. Frye was born on April 10, 1984, in
3 Oconto, Wisconsin, and died on Monday, February 16, 2004, in Ba'qubah, Iraq, while
4 serving in Operation Iraqi Freedom; and

5 Whereas, Spc. Frye served with honor as a U.S. Army Civil Affairs soldier with
6 the 432nd Civil Affairs Battalion out of Green Bay until, upon deployment, she was
7 transferred to the 415th Civil Affairs Battalion out of Kalamazoo, Michigan; and

8 Whereas, Spc. Frye graduated from Lena High School in 2002, where she
9 participated in FFA, and she was an accomplished musician in the band for 8 years;

11 Whereas, Spc. Frye made the ultimate sacrifice in defense of her country; and

12 Whereas, Spc. Frye will always be remembered for her bravery and courage and
13 will never be forgotten; now, therefore, be it

14 ***Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That*** the members of the
15 Wisconsin legislature commend the life and devoted service of U.S. Army Specialist

1 Nichole M. Frye, express their sorrow at her death, and extend their condolences to
2 her family and friends; and, be it further

3 ***Resolved, That*** the assembly chief clerk shall provide copies of this joint
4 resolution to Spc. Frye's mother and father, Jayme and Lisa Frye of the Town of Little
5 River; to her sister, Crystal Frye; to her brother, William Frye; and to her fiance,
6 Jeremy Stumpf of Oconto.
