2003 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 13

April 18, 2003 – Introduced by Representatives LASSA, HAHN, BOYLE, JESKEWITZ, PLOUFF and HUBER. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **Relating to:** commending the public service of the environmentalist Ingeborg Lothe
2 upon her induction into the Wisconsin Conservation Hall of Fame.

3 Whereas, Ingeborg Lothe was born in Columbia County on September 16, 1915;
4 and

5 Whereas, Ingeborg Lothe grew up on the Jens and Helga Viken homestead in
6 rural Sun Prairie where she attended a one-room school for her early years of
7 education, later graduating from Madison East High School; and

8 Whereas, Ingeborg Lothe was the first woman elected chair of the Columbia
9 County Board, and served on the Governor’s Council on Forest Productivity from
10 1983 to 1986 and the Wisconsin Waste Facility Siting Board from 1984 to 1990; and

11 Whereas, Ingeborg Lothe was a pioneer in local and regional recycling efforts,
12 chairing the Columbia County Solid Waste Commission when it developed its
13 innovative recycling program that was recognized by the National Recycling
14 Coalition in 1986 for being the “most outstanding regional recycling plan in the
15 nation”; and
