



2003 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 35

March 2, 2004 - Introduced by COMMITTEE ON RULES.

1 **Relating to:** establishing special orders of business for Thursday, March 4, 2004.

2 ***Resolved by the assembly, That:***

SECTION 1. Special order scheduled. The following proposals shall be special orders of business on Thursday, March 4, 2004, at the times shown:

- (1) At 9:00 a.m., 2003 Assembly Joint Resolution 66, relating to: providing that only a marriage between one man and one woman shall be valid or recognized as a marriage in this state (first consideration).
- (2) At 9:01 a.m., 2003 Assembly Bill 516, relating to: an exemption from the requirement to obtain an air pollution construction permit for certain equipment at a nonmetallic mineral processing facility.
- (3) At 9:02 a.m., 2003 Assembly Bill 629, relating to: the plan period for county forest land use plans.
- (4) At 9:03 a.m., 2003 Assembly Bill 836, relating to: the Milwaukee Parental Choice Program and granting rule-making authority.
- (5) At 9:04 a.m., 2003 Assembly Bill 847, relating to: the Milwaukee Parental Choice Program and granting rule-making authority.
- (6) At 9:05 a.m., 2003 Senate Bill 272, relating to: local government telecommunications utilities and public hearings for ordinances and resolutions authorizing local government cable television, telecommunications, and Internet access facilities.

- (7) At 9:06 a.m., 2003 Senate Bill 8, relating to: withholding certain security information from public inspection.
- (8) At 9:07 a.m., 2003 Assembly Bill 598, relating to: employment relations under the Municipal Employment Relations Act.

SECTION 2. Twelve hour notice. Consideration of the special order of business established in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall occur at the time shown in that section or 12 hours after adoption of this resolution, whichever is later.
