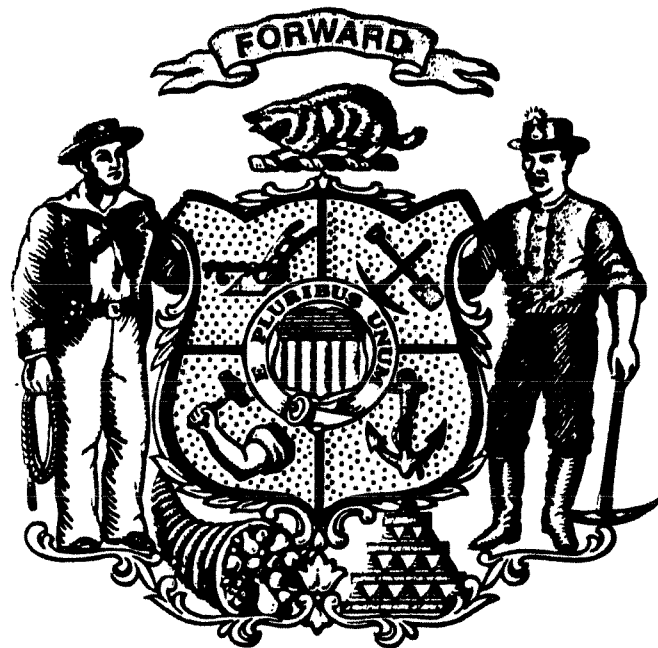

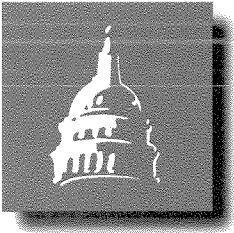

Dear Representative Kreibich:

Recently I introduced Assembly Bill 204, which was referred to your committee earlier this week.

Currently, the technical colleges are able to seek private sector partners for the purpose of securing financing to match local resources for the construction of Applied Technology Centers. Several of our Tech Colleges have taken advantage of this provision since 1999. The provision has a sunset date of July 2003. As some of the colleges are in the process of securing partners for these centers, they have requested a two-year extension of the sunset date. AB 204 simply extends the sunset date to July 2005.

In the interest of moving this bill along, I would like to request that a public hearing be scheduled in the Committee on Colleges and Universities at your earliest convenience.

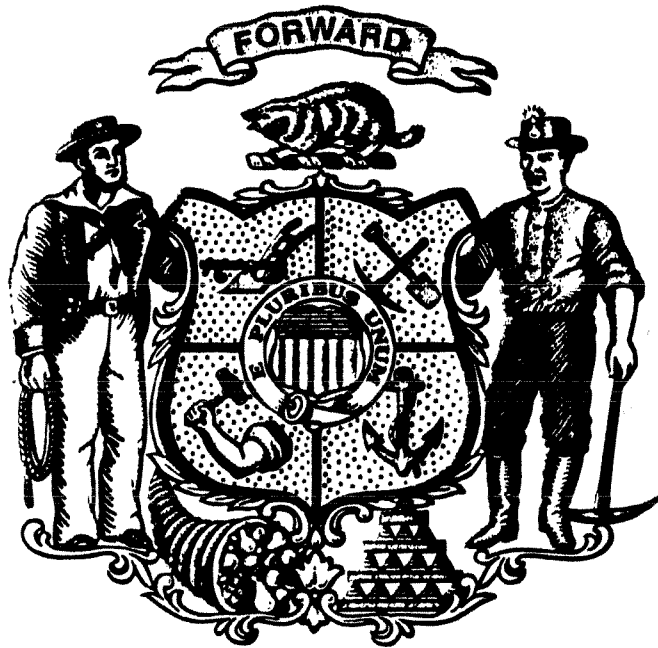

Dear Representative Kriebich:

It was brought to my attention today that you have scheduled a hearing for Tuesday, May 20, 2003 to discuss, among other items, AB204. While my schedule does not allow me to attend the hearing, I want to register my support for this critical proposed legislation that would extend the language of Applied Technology Centers through June, 30, 2005.

Chippewa Valley Technical College has submitted an Applied Technology Center application to the WTCS for the proposed CVTC Health Education Center expansion. In fact, the WTCS will take action on the application at its' Board meeting on Wednesday, May 21, 2003. As you are aware, the legislation requires a 30% private sector match for the borrowing that is allowed. Our application requires a \$1,784,496 private sector match to borrow \$4,163,825. We have until June 30, 2003 to raise the funds. If we cannot raise the funds and the legislation is not extended, CVTC will need to raise an additional \$4,163,825. This would be extremely detrimental to us since we have leveraged federal, state, local, and private funds and have plans to begin construction for the Health Education Center late this summer. The current Phillips Health Center is bursting at the seams. Closets are being used for faculty offices. A student lounge has been converted to a Nursing Lab, students study on the hall floors. CVTC must continue to provide the necessary programming for the health industry in our district, and we need an adequate facility to provide the education for our students now.

I would strongly urge your support of AB204. This legislation is budget neutral and has been used successfully with public approval at both Moraine Park and Gateway Technical Colleges.
