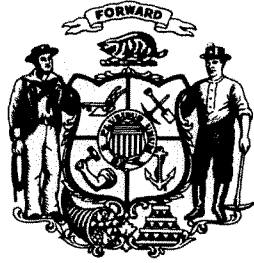


**Assembly Bill 812...** relating to: registration of livestock premises and granting rule-making authority.

<p><b>BILL SPONSORS</b></p>	<p>Introduced by Senators <b>Schultz</b>, Lassa, <b>Brown</b>, <b>Kedzie</b> and Hansen. Cosponsored by Representative <b>Ward</b>.</p>
<p><b>BILL HISTORY</b></p>	<p>Assembly Bill 812 was introduced on 02-05-04 and referred to the Assembly Committee on Agriculture. A Joint Public Hearing was held by the Assembly and Senate Ag Committees on 02-19-04 On 02-19-04 The Assembly Committee held an executive session. Assembly substitute amendment 1 was offered. Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 adoption was recommended by the Assembly Committee on Agriculture, <b>Ayes 13, Noes 0</b> and passage as amended recommended <b>Ayes 13, Noes 0</b>. On 02-24-04. AB 812 was Read a third time and passed, <b>Ayes 97, Noes 0</b> On 02-25-04. AB 812 was read for the first time and referred to committee on Agriculture, Financial Institutions and Insurance On 02-26-04. Executive action taken. <b>On 02-27-04 The committee recommended AB 812 for passage on a vote. Ayes 5, Noes 0</b></p>
<p><b>LRB ANALYSIS</b></p>	<p><b>Current Law:</b> Under current law, the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) conducts various activities to protect animal health and food safety.</p> <p><b>Proposed Changes:</b> This bill requires certain persons who keep livestock in this state to register with DATCP. For the purposes of this bill, "livestock" means cattle and bison, horses, goats, poultry, sheep, swine, deer, and any other kind of animal that DATCP identifies by rule. To be covered by this bill, a person keeping poultry must have more than 20 animals and a person keeping horses must have more than five animals. The bill requires DATCP to assign a premises code to each location where livestock are kept and to maintain a data base containing the codes and related information. Information provided to DATCP under this bill must generally be kept confidential, except for information that is required to be provided under other laws. The bill authorizes DATCP to contract with an agent to administer the livestock premises registration program. Under current law, DATCP makes payments to owners of animals that DATCP orders killed to control animal disease. Current law specifies several situations in which owners are not eligible for these payments. Under this bill, the owner of an animal that DATCP orders to be killed to control animal disease is not eligible for a payment from DATCP if the person did not register as required by the bill.</p> <p><b>Major Impact:</b> Improve Livestock Tracking related to disease monitoring.</p>
