     **LRBa0581/2** - The Commercial Lending Definition Amendment is a simple amendment to the substitute. It changes the wording of the sentence in proposed s. 109.09 (2) (c) 2. in favor of the first option to make it clear that the first \$3,000 of a wage lien will take precedence over a commercial lender. The amendment deletes the "to the extent language." Instead, the sentence now states that a wage lien will take precedence over a prior lien of a commercial institution "as to the first \$3,000 of unpaid wages covered under the lien" and only as to wages earned within the six months preceding the date the employee files a wage claim with DWD or the date the employee brings his or her own action to collect the wages.

     **LRBa0567/2** - The Wage Lien Definition Amendment is a simple amendment to the substitute. It defines the term "commercial lending institution" as having the same definition as "financial institution" as in s. 243.01 (5k). That subsection defines a financial institution as "a bank, savings bank, savings and loan association, credit union, insurance company, finance company, mortgage banker registered under s. 224.72, community development corporation, small business investment corporation, pension fund or other lender which provides commercial loans in this state."
