
Wisconsin Council for Administrators of Special Services The School Administrators Alliance (SAA) strongly supports Senate Bill 107, relating to school and school district performance reports.


Under current law, each school board must by January 1st each year distribute to the parent or guardian of each student enrolled in the district a copy of the school and school district performance report as well as a comparison of the district's performance with that of other school districts in the same athletic conference. If enacted, SB 107 would:

- Change the date by which the district is required to distribute the report from January 1st to May 1st each year. Much of the data required for the report is not available in time for districts to meet the current deadline.
- Require that school districts send the report only to those parents or guardians who request it. Sending the report to every student household only to have it routinely discarded is a waste of taxpayer resources.
- Require that the report be posted on the school district Internet site, if the district maintains such a site. This requirement would increase the public's accessibility to this information by making it available 24/7.
- Eliminate the required comparison of school district performance with the performance of other districts in the same athletic conference. This comparison expanded the size of the report as well as the staff resources necessary to complete and distribute the report. Also, this comparative information is readily available on the DPI web site and other sources.

The school and school district performance report was established by the Legislature as an accountability measure to keep parents and taxpayers informed of their school district's performance. SB 107, if enacted, would continue to meet this accountability objective. In fact, this bill would foster greater public accessibility to the report by making it available on school district web sites. And, it would do so with a more efficient use of taxpayer resources that would allow school districts to achieve savings (printing, mailing and other costs) that could help meet student needs in this difficult fiscal environment.

The Wisconsin Association of School Boards supports Senate Bill 107, relating to school performance report requirements.

Currently, each school board must distribute a copy of the school and school district performance report to the parent or guardian of each pupil enrolled in the district. The report contains numerous performance indicators and compares performance to other school districts in the athletic conference. The cost to print and mail the lengthy report continues to increase.

The school performance reports are valuable in disseminating information about individual districts and the achievement of their students. The report is also useful in targeting areas for continued improvement in curriculum and programs. However, maximizing resources is also essential to districts and they would like to produce and distribute the reports in a more cost-effective manner. Senate Bill 107 would give school boards the flexibility to mail school district performance reports upon request. Parents, guardians and other interested parties would have easy access to the reports by either visiting the district's Internet site or by requesting a copy.

Furthermore, Senate Bill 107 would eliminate the required comparison of the school district to other districts in the athletic conference. These comparisons are readily available on the Department of Public Instruction's WINSS Web site. Including the comparisons in the district report has lengthened the documents and increased the cost to produce and mail them.

School boards need the authority to manage in more cost-effective ways. This bill preserves the school performance report, while allowing for cost efficiency. The WASB urges your support of Senate Bill 107.


