This memorandum responds to your request for general information on appointments. It also categorizes the appointees that were pending before the Senate and that were withdrawn by Governor Doyle on inauguration day.

Appointments to boards, councils, commissions, examining boards, and other entities in state government are made in a variety of ways. The statutes specify, for each entity, how appointments to that entity are made. Frequently, the Governor is required to make appointments to these entities. These appointments may, or may not, require the advice and consent of the Senate before the appointments become effective. If advice and consent of the Senate is required for a specific appointment, this requirement is specified in the statutes. It is important to consult the statutes for each individual entity to determine how appointments to that entity are made and when advice and consent of the Senate is required.

When a new Legislature is organized on the first Monday in January of each odd-numbered year [s. 13.02 (1)], any appointments then pending before the Senate are referred by the Senate president to the appropriate standing committee of the newly organized Senate. [s. 17.20 (2), Stats.] At that time, the Senate could act to confirm any of the appointments then pending before the Senate.

The Governor also takes office on the first Monday in January. [s. 8.25 (4), Stats.] It is common for a new Governor, upon taking office, to withdraw some of the pending appointments made by the previous Governor, and to nominate persons of the Governor's own choosing.

The legal status of pending appointees depends upon the circumstances under which they were appointed. Some of the different circumstances of these appointments are as follows:

1. **Appointees who are appointed to fill a vacancy in an appointive office (provisional appointees).**

Under s. 17.20 (2), Stats., vacancies occurring in the office of any officer normally nominated by the Governor, and with the advice and consent of the Senate appointed, may be filled by a provisional

appointment by the Governor for the residue of the unexpired term, if any, subject to confirmation by the Senate. Any such appointment is in full force until acted upon by the Senate. If the appointee is confirmed by the Senate, the appointee continues to serve for the residue of the unexpired term, if any, or until a successor is chosen and qualifies. A provisional appointee may exercise all of the powers and duties of the office while serving as provisional appointee. However, a provisional appointment which is withdrawn by the Governor or is rejected by the Senate lapses. When a provisional appointment lapses, a vacancy occurs.

If the Governor withdraws a provisional appointment, the Governor may fill the vacancy created by making another provisional appointment. The new provisional appointee is fully empowered to exercise the office until the appointee qualifies by Senate confirmation, or is rejected by the Senate.

The following provisional appointees were pending before the Senate before being withdrawn by Governor Doyle on January 6, 2003. The withdrawal of these appointments created vacancies that may be filled by new provisional appointments.

2. Persons who are nominated to succeed an officeholder whose term is expiring (holdovers).

When an officeholder's term expires, there is no vacancy in the office if the officeholder "holds over" in the office until the new appointee is confirmed. A person who is nominated to succeed an officeholder whose term is expiring may not exercise the powers and duties of the office to which they are appointed until confirmed by the Senate. Until the Senate confirms the appointment, the prior officeholder (known as a "holdover") exercises the powers of the office. [*State ex rel. Thompson v. Gibson*, 22 Wis. 2d 275, 125 N.W.2d 636 (1964).]

Frequently, an officeholder is nominated to succeed himself or herself (i.e., is "reappointed"). In that case, the person who is reappointed is a holdover, and continues to exercise all of the powers of the office, pending his or her confirmation (or rejection) by the Senate.

In the case where a holdover is in appointive office for which there is a fixed term, the Governor may not remove the person except for cause. [s. 17.07 (3).] Also, the Governor may not make a provisional appointment, because provisional appointments may only be made when vacancies occur, and the expiration of a prior term does not create a vacancy if there is a holdover in the office. The new Governor may make a new nomination, but the holdover could continue in office until such time as the Senate confirmed the new nominee.

The following holdover appointees were pending before the Senate before being withdrawn by Governor Doyle on January 6, 2003. Although these appointees were withdrawn, these persons may continue to serve as holdovers until the new appointees are confirmed by the Senate.

3. Persons who are nominated to fill a newly created office.

Persons who are nominated to a newly created office may not exercise any of the powers of the office until confirmed by the Senate. They are not considered provisional appointees, and there is no holdover to exercise the powers of the office. [66 OAG 33 (1977).] Exceptions to this situation could occur where the Legislature has specifically authorized the Governor to provisionally appoint officers to a newly created office pending confirmation by the Senate. An example of this was the creation of the College Savings Program Board. In 1999 Wisconsin Act 44, SECTION 15, the Legislature gave the Governor the authority to provisionally appoint the members of that board. The provisional appointments are in force until withdrawn by the Governor or acted upon by the Senate. If a provisional appointment to this board is withdrawn, the appointment lapses upon withdrawal, and a vacancy is created that could be filled with another provisional appointee. 

I had just returned from a meeting at the City of Brookfield attended by Senators Panzer, Kanavas and Reynolds as well as Assembly Members Gard and Vukmir, when I picked up today's Milwaukee Journal Sentinel, Waukesha Section, and read the article "More board members resist displacement". This article in conjunction with the Brookfield meeting gave me pause to write.

There was unanimity at the Brookfield meeting that Wisconsin's economic doldrums are a result of over regulation and over taxation.

From my perspective one of the most offensive agencies from an over regulatory standpoint is the DNR.

The problem with the DNR is not only with the regulations they dictate which they "have" to enforce, but with the bureaucratic interpretation and enforcement of those regulations, often by state employees with a single focused agenda that lies well outside of the mainstream of normal common sense. 

Thanks for taking a few minutes from your very busy schedule to review with me appointments that have been made by Governor Doyle to the Labor, Industry and Review Commission. As we both know what Doyle has created are appointments which if confirmed would allow favorable treatment for his labor constituents of all issues regarding workmen's compensation claims, unemployment insurance issues, equal employment rights issues brought to LIRC for review. As we discussed, it is my understanding that Commissioner Falstad would stay on if reappointed. As we know, last year Senator Chvala refused to reconfirm the continuation of Falstad's appointment to serve as commissioner. Additionally, Chvala refused to confirm the appointment of Laurie McCallum as a new commissioner replacement.

What Doyle has effectively done now is to appoint two people, one to replace Falstad and of course the other McCallum, who were supported heavily by labor and have a strong debt to the organized labor interest. The Republican Party must now do what Chvala did and deny confirmation of these two appointments. Otherwise, if done, they would serve staggered six year terms which would set the legal agenda in work comp and unemployment compensation issues for the next half decade.



TALKING POINTS FOR SENATE REPUBLICANS: DOYLE RESCINDS APPOINTMENTS

- Shortly after taking office, Governor Doyle withdrew 127 pending appointments to citizen oversight boards. Their official confirmations had been unfairly held up for months by former Senate Majority Leader Chuck Chvala for partisan reasons.
- Doyle acted, after telling others in private conversations over the past few weeks that he wasn't going to make any hasty decisions, and that he was going to think about the appointments for awhile.
- In those discussions, Doyle acknowledged the damage that had been done to Wisconsin's system of citizen government by Senator Chvala's refusal to schedule confirmation hearings.
- Governor Doyle certainly enjoys the power and authority to make CABINET and AGENCY appointments. The Senate will provide fair and timely consideration to such appointments.
- However, the issue of citizen appointments is a different matter. They're not intended to change simply because there's been a partisan change in the executive branch.
- This is quite serious. Citizens appointed to boards offer insight, expertise, and real world experience.
- Citizens on oversight boards reduce partisanship, and keep the bureaucracy in check.
- To rescind so many appointments at one time prevents the achievement of any continuity on these boards.
- No citizen who was unfairly denied a confirmation hearing should be prevented from serving his or her full term.
- Senator Chvala abused the system, and trampled on Wisconsin's tradition of citizen government. Governor Doyle rescinding of these appointments allows what Senator Chvala started to continue.
- Governor Doyle should reconsider what he's done, and re-nominate the appointments he withdrew, just hours after taking the oath of office.
