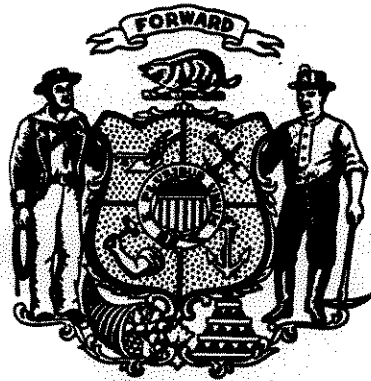

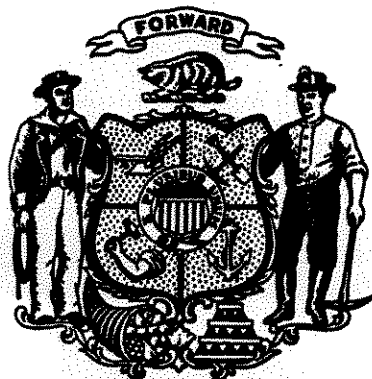

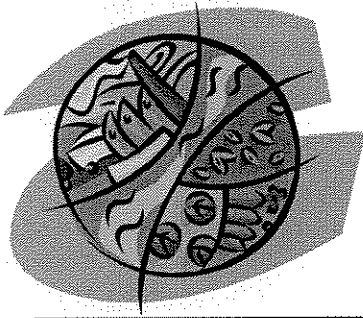

Attendance

With the exception of polling, or paper balloting, a member must be present in order to be recorded as voting. The voting roll will be closed after all members who have indicated their presence have voted, and members may not vote on motions before the Committee once the roll is closed. Public Hearings

The chair may limit public testimony to five minutes per speaker. Latitude will be given at the chair's discretion – particularly to primary bill authors or agency experts.


Executive Sessions

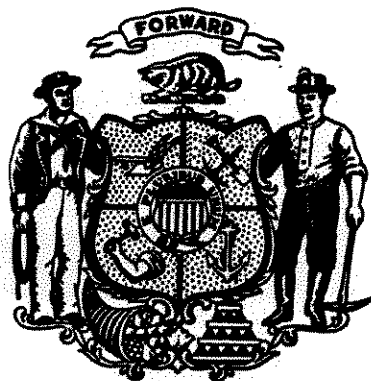

Clearinghouse Rules

The following Clearinghouse Rules have been referred to the Senate Environment and Natural Resources Committee:

Clearinghouse Rule 02-098; water safety patrols

RULE SUMMARY

1. Proposed rule would allow water safety patrols on Lake Winnebago to be reimbursed for salary expenses of 3 officers per boat patrol instead of current 2.
2. Proposed rule would change deadlines for reimbursement of ATV and snowmobile patrols to be more in line with county fiscal responsibilities, department personal auditing and existing snowmobile deadlines.
3. Requirement of the department to send three reimbursement forms reduced to one.
4. Proposed rule would lift \$100 reimbursement ATV equipment purchase cap.
5. Proposed rule changes reimbursement formula to reflect actual work performed rather than just an across the board percentage.

FISCAL EFFECT

No state or local fiscal effect.

- **Section 1.** Amends the deadline for filing the Intent to Patrol form to June 1 for Snowmobile Patrols and amends the requirement for the Department to mail 3 sets of forms to each patrol, to require the Department to send one set of forms.
- **Section 2.** Establishes a separate minimum ratio of on-water patrol hours per arrest for patrols that operate on outlying waters or on lakes of over 100,000 acres to reflect their additional personnel costs.
- **Section 3.** Add patrols that operate on lakes of over 100,000 acres to those patrols that are authorized to staff their patrol boats with 3 officers.

- **Section 4.** Amends the requirement for the Department to mail 3 sets of forms to each patrol, to require the Department to mail one set of forms to each patrol
- **Section 5.** Amends the deadline dates for filing claims and Intent to Patrol forms to June 1 for ATV Patrols. Amends the cost limit for equipment that is required to be depreciated from \$100 to \$1000. Amends the requirement for the Department to mail 3 sets of forms to each patrol, to require the Department to send one set of forms and changes the funds disbursement date to October 1.

Clearinghouse Rule 02-096; commercial fishing in Lake Superior

RULE SUMMARY

Proposed rule establishes new lake trout harvest limits as agreed to by the department and the Red Cliff and Bad River Bands of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians and includes three changes:

1. The harvest limit will increase from 714 lake trout to 886 lake trout
2. Requirement that lake herring fill nets be set at least 12 feet beneath the surface to reduce the risk of recreation boats becoming tangled in said nets
3. Requirement that all floats or leads on gill nets set by state licensed commercial fishers on Lake Superior be marked with the commercial fisher's license number. That will help the department identify abandoned gill nets.

FISCAL EFFECT

No state or local fiscal effect.

Clearinghouse Rule 02-061; aquatic plant management

RULE SUMMARY

Proposed rule complies with 2001 WI Act 16 (2001-03 budget) for the protection of aquatic plant communities and the control of invasive species. The department may require a permit application to contain an aquatic plant management plan (phased in over time).

The rule provides application procedures, specific fees, and conditions for approval or denial, and penalties for violations.

FISCAL EFFECT

The department assumes it will issue 125 permits at an average of \$240 per permit, generating \$30,000 in revenue annually. Fee revenue is expected to offset permit administration costs.

SUPPORTORS

None.

OPPOSITION

Ten individuals appeared at NR Board hearings in opposition. In addition, Senator Stepp's office is concerned with this rule based on the number "easy-out" denials for permits afforded the department. Such as:

- Aquatic plants are not causing significant impairment of beneficial water use activities. **(As determined by the department, I would assume)**
- The proposed introduction or control will not provide effective relief of the water use impairment caused by aquatic plants. **(In other words, it won't work)** *per DNR*

Senator Stepp's office is going to review this as she was a member of the NR Board when this was being drafted. She may request a hearing.

Assembly Amendment 1 specifies that the educational requirements in the bill apply to field foresters. The amendment also deletes the phrase "from a school located in another country."

This bill eliminates the requirement that a person, in order to obtain a wild turkey hunting license as a qualified resident landowner, must agree to allow other persons to hunt wild turkey on the land.

✓ **Assembly Bill 106**

This bill allows a person who is issued a Class A bear license to transfer that license to a person who is at least 12 years old but under the age of 18. The minor may then use the license to pursue, bait, and hunt bear as authorized by a Class A bear license.

Summary of CR 02-145

The proposed revisions adjust the plan review and license fees to address projected deficits in the Program Revenue account beginning in Fiscal Year 2004.

Owners or operators of landfills shall pay a license fee surcharge to the department based upon the number of tons or equivalent volume of solid waste disposed of at each landfill during each quarterly reporting period.

The tonnage rate shall be **9.0 cents/ton** through September 30, 2003, **12.0 cents/ton** effective October 1, 2003, **14 cents/ton** effective July 1, 2004, and **15.0 cents/ton** effective July 1, 2005 and beyond.

DNR says the fee increase is necessary to offset a deficit in the program. Waste haulers and recyclers may begrudgingly accept this increase as they know it is necessary in order to get the staff to manage their permits.

Summary of CR 03-035

This rule makes a number of changes to various DNR rules relating to state owned land. Many are rather innocuous but some may merit discussion:

Prohibition of Commercial Photography - NR 45.04(3)(f)

No person may engage in commercial filming or photography or provide services for a fee that involves the provider's physical presence in the state park, state recreation area or southern forest unless first authorized by contractual agreement or a department commercial use permit.

The commercial use permit is \$30 per year and the Department is fully aware of who the commercial photographers are who use the parks. According to the DNR, it is not their intent to shut down or harass amateur photographers.

Various Fee Increases

1. Campgrounds

- Campground electricity goes up from \$3 to \$5 per unit per night
- Additional camping fees may be charged for waterview campsites not to exceed \$5.00 per night for type A and B campgrounds.
- Group rate 1 to 20 persons go up from \$30 to \$40 per night
- Each additional interval of 10 goes up from \$15 to \$20 per night
- Minimum per group goes up from \$30 to \$40 per night

- Point Beach state forest will be \$5 per person per day; \$60 minimum per group per day

2. Trails and other miscellaneous fee increases

- Annual change from \$10 to \$15
- Daily change from \$3 to \$5

- Children (2-12) . . . change from \$.50 to \$1 per day

- Rock Island state park overnight boat mooring fee from \$.60 to \$1 per foot of length per night

Summary of AB 13

Assembly Bill 13 expands the authority of the DNR to sell damaged timber by allowing DNR to sell timber on any land under the DNR's jurisdiction and to include timber damaged by snow, hail, or ice.

As amended, a county may sell timber damaged by fire, wind, snow, hail, or ice, on the terms and in the manner that the county determines is in the county's best interest. In addition, the DNR and a county may sell timber damaged by insects or disease.

The amendment also specifies that a county selling damaged timber must continue following the contract and cutting limitations and presale appraisal requirements for county timber sales in current law.

Summary of AB 200

This bill prohibits DNR from promulgating or enforcing a rule that prohibits a person from sighting a firearm on land owned or leased by that person or a member of that person's immediate family during that same 24-hour period in any area where there is an open season for hunting deer with firearms.
