

DON H. DAVIS CHAIRMAN & CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER

Don H. Davis became chairman and chief executive officer of Rockwell International Corporation, a global electronic controls and communications company, in 1998.

Davis, who joined Allen-Bradley in 1963 (acquired by Rockwell in 1985) as an engineering sales trainee, has held a series of key corporate and business unit executive positions culminating with being named Rockwell's president and chief executive officer in 1997.

Prior to being named CEO, Davis had been president and chief operating officer since 1995. He also served as executive vice president and chief operating officer with responsibility for Rockwell's automation and former semiconductor systems and automotive components businesses.

Prior to his corporate appointment, Davis served as corporate senior vice president and president-Automation, a position he assumed in 1993. Davis was also president of Rockwell's Allen-Bradley business. He was named to that position in 1989.

As president of Allen-Bradley, Davis provided the leadership for significant growth outside the United States, as well as the establishment of a number of very successful commercial initiatives (partnerships/alliances, global accounts program) which laid the foundation for what has become one of the world's leading automation businesses, Rockwell Automation.

Davis joined Allen-Bradley's Sales Division in 1963 and was steadily appointed to posts of greater responsibility. In 1966, he became a district manager for the company's sales office in Birmingham, Alabama. In 1979, Davis was appointed general manager of Allen-Bradley's Programmable Controller Division. A year later, he was named vice president of that unit. He became vice president and general manager of the Industrial Control Division in 1982.

Davis was promoted to senior vice president at Allen-Bradley in 1985 and became head of the Industrial Control Group in 1986. In 1987, Davis was named senior vice president and general manager of the Industrial Computer and Communication Group, and in 1989 he was appointed president of Allen-Bradley.

Davis earned a bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering and a master's degree in business administration at Texas A&M University.

In addition to the Rockwell board, Davis is a member of the board of directors of Illinois Tool Works, Apogent Technologies, and Ingram Micro. He is also a member of the Business Council, the Business Roundtable, The Conference Board and is past chairman of the Board of Governors of the National Electrical Manufacturers Association, Washington, DC.

In the areas of education and community involvement, Davis serves on the board of the Business Committee for the Arts and as a regent for the Milwaukee School of Engineering. He is also a member of a number of educational and civic councils, including the Greater Milwaukee Committee, the Board of Trustees for the Museum of Science and Industry and is a National Trustee for Boys and Girls Clubs of America. He was also co-chairperson for the 2000 United Performing Arts Fund campaign. Milwaukee-based UPAF is the second largest united arts fundraising organization in the United States.

Rockwell is a \$7 billion electronic controls and communications company with global leadership positions in industrial automation, avionics and communications, and electronic commerce. The company employs approximately 40,000 people at more than 450 locations serving customers in more than 80 countries.

15.085 Affiliated credentialing boards. (1) SELECTION OF MEMBERS. All members of affiliated credentialing boards shall be residents of this state and shall, unless otherwise provided by law, be nominated by the governor, and with the advice and consent of the senate appointed. * * * No member may serve more than 2 consecutive terms. No member of an affiliated credentialing board may be an officer, director or employe of a private organization which promotes or furthers the profession or occupation regulated by that board.

(am) Public members appointed under s. 15.406 shall not be, nor ever have been, licensed, certified, registered or engaged in any profession or occupation licensed or otherwise regulated by the affiliated credentialing board to which they are appointed, shall not be married to any person so licensed, certified, registered or engaged, and shall not employ, be employed by or be professionally associated with any person so licensed, certified, registered or engaged.

15.406 Department of regulation and licensing; attached affiliated credentialing boards. (4) ATHLETIC TRAINERS AFFILIATED CREDENTIALING BOARD. There is created in the department of regulation and licensing, attached to the medical examining board, an athletic trainers affiliated credentialing board consisting of the following members appointed for 4-year terms:

- (a) Four athletic trainers who are licensed under subch. VI of ch. 448 and who have not been issued a credential in athletic training by a governmental authority in a jurisdiction outside this state. One of the athletic trainer members may also be licensed under ch. 446 or 447 or subch. II, III or IV of ch. 448
- (b) One member who is licensed to practice medicine and surgery under subch. Il of ch. 448 and who has experience with athletic training and sports medicine.
- (c) One public member.
