It is our intent to conduct a diligent and timely review of the Governor's cabinet appointments. Public hearings should be held on these appointments to allow appropriate public input. Whenever possible, these hearings should be scheduled far enough in advance so that the hearing can be listed in the weekly schedule of committee activities. Sufficient public notice should be given in any case to allow members of the public who wish to testify on the appointment to do so.

Please be advised that committees historically have not voted on appointments of the Governor unless a statement of economic interest is on file. For nominees who were previously nominated but not confirmed by the Senate, the statement should already be on file. For new nominees, you should receive the statement of economic interest before having a public hearing and taking executive action.
